- Administer medications
- Recognize an emergency
- Perform CPR, First Aid and choking skills
- Treat common emergencies such as cuts, scrapes and bleeding
- Build a pet first aid kit

After completing a Pet First Aid course, participant Sallyann Beaver put her knowledge to use when her cat, Peaches, went into sudden cardiac arrest. Because of Sallyann's training, she was able to recognize the symptoms and administer the proper care.

My class instructor showed me how to check my cat's heart beat and I was able to practice the skill on a pet manikin.
